Some interesting facts:

Application is allowed from 15 years and 9 months. Joining age from 16 years old to 39 years.

All RN/RM Apprenticeships are fully accredited.

Salary is paid from day one of training unlike college.

98% of all rating (non-commissioned) roles are signed up to an L2 apprenticeship on entry. Musicians and Divers don't as they have their own qualifications.

Most roles don't require any formal qualifications as they have their own entry test and that is the one which is required.

Each role has a different score so not all require the same level of academic ability.

L3 up to L7 are available as personnel progress through their careers.

12% of the RN/RM are apprentices at any one time. Currently that figure is just over 4,500 ratings.

You will need to be physically fit.
